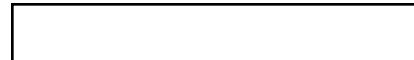

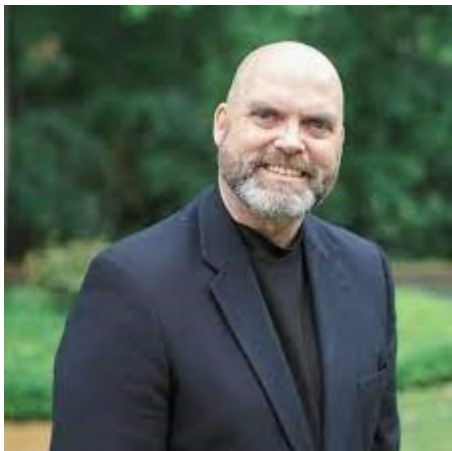

SINGLE FRIENDS GROUP

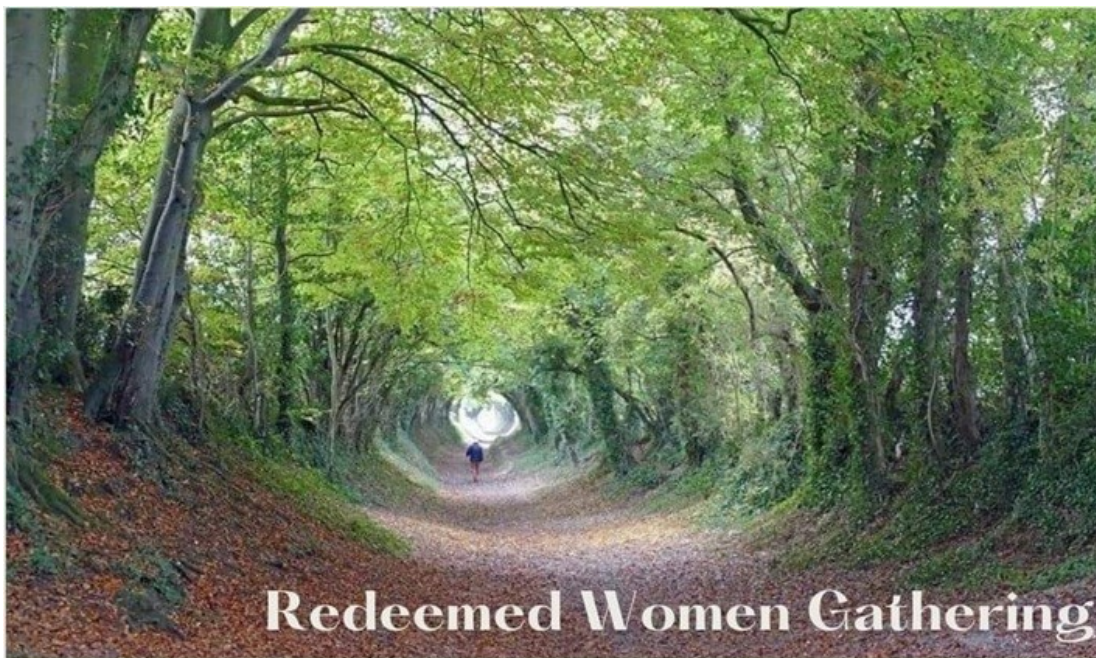
