Current Madison UMC Reopening Plans and Guidelines

“Building Faithful Disciples, Serving Jesus Christ”

We have resumed in-person worship services on our campus. We also stream the 8:30 a.m. worship service on our YouTube channel. After the service is streamed, it is quickly uploaded to YouTube for you to watch anytime.

Sanctuary - 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

- Masks are required. They must cover your **mouth and nose** and must be worn when you are on our campus.
- Please park in the west parking lot (Church Office) and enter by the west and south (Main Street) entrances of the Sanctuary.

Education Building - 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

- Sunday School rooms on the second floor of the **Education Building** will be set aside for **nursing mothers, for parents with infants, and for overflow crowds.**
- Masks are required. They must cover your **mouth and nose** and must be worn when you are on our campus.
- Please park in the east parking lot (Covered drive through) and enter by the east Atrium entrance

Guidelines

- Time your arrival for 10 minutes prior to the start of the service.
- Family units may sit next to each other in worship, but everyone must practice social distancing.
- Offering baskets will be placed at the exits of each room.
- We will not use bulletins, pew Bibles, or hymnals during this stage.
- A nursery and on-site Sunday School classes **cannot** be offered during this reopening stage on Sunday mornings.

Registration

- Please register each week (<https://madisonumc.thersvpapp.com/>) by noting your preferred attendance time. This can be done by signing in at the designated tab on our website or you can call our church office for assistance.

Reminders

- **In case of rain, the covered drop-off entrance will be available** for those attending the service in the sanctuary, too.
- All doors will be opened for you by Greeters. Ushers will direct you to your seating. They will both be wearing face coverings.
- The sanctuary will be cleaned between services.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be readily available throughout the building.
- There will be no coffee stations or food available during this time. We also ask that you do not bring your own food or coffee to the campus.
- Please sneeze or cough into a tissue or the inside of your elbow.
- We will have music at these worship services, but congregational singing may not be part of our worship for a short season as part of our phased approach as we continue to explore how to best minimize risk.
- The length of the services will be moderately abbreviated, so Sunday School classes should be able to meet via Zoom from 9:40 a.m.-10:30 a.m.
- Individuals with serious underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma, and those whose immune systems are compromised (such as chemotherapy and other conditions requiring such therapy) are encouraged to stay at home and join us online. The CDC has reported that older adults and people with these listed conditions “seem to be at higher risk for developing more serious complication from COVID-19 illness.”
- Those who have a fever and/or feel sick should stay at home and join us for worship online.

DRIVE-THROUGH COMMUNION ON AUGUST 30

We will hold a Drive-Through Communion Service from 4:00-6:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 30. We will have communion cups with bread and juice available for you, or you can bring juice and bread with you. We will have more details about this special event in the next newsletter but please reserve that afternoon for this service.

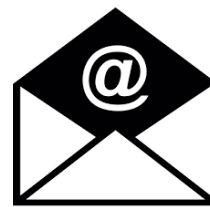


WEDNESDAYS AT MADISON

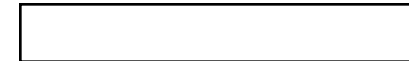

HOW TO PRE-REGISTER FOR SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP SERVICES

In order to plan well for safe, hospitable gathering for worship on campus, we ask that you plan and pre-register your worship attendance by going to <https://madisonumc.thersvpapp.com>. Once you are there, you simply:

- 1) click on the blue **SIGN-UP NOW** button;
- 2) then **CHOOSE** which worship time you would like to attend;
- 3) then **CHOOSE** your seats if there are enough available for you/your household;
- 4) then use the **+/- buttons** to add the number of seats needed and click **CONTINUE**;
- 5) scroll down and input your **BASIC CONTACT INFO** then **SEND RSVP**. You should see a confirmation message and receive a confirmation email.

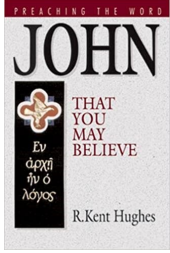
