Last year, we had wonderful times of worship, fellowship, and sharing each night during Lent with our inaugural nightly Zoom Lent Worship Gatherings. Lent begins in early March (Ash Wednesday is March 2). We invite you to join us as often as you are able or wish. The formal worship time will be 7:00-7:20 pm each night with different MUMC members and staff serving as "WORSHIP HOSTS" each night. You can join the Zoom conference as early as 6:45 for a time of informal fellowship with others. Because Lent does not include the Sundays, we will not do Sunday nights and will likely not have it on Ash Wednesday or Maundy Thursday due to special Lent services.

Lent is 40 days, and we have chosen to do Tim Tennent's **30 QUESTIONS** and **10 COMMANDMENTS** devotionals to focus on basic Christian beliefs and ways of living God's will that Christians have been grounded in for centuries. Lent has often had a focus on grounding new believers and renewing seasoned believers in the fundamentals of the Christian faith. These 20 minute worship times will include prayer, Scripture, singing (you will sing on mute!), a devotional reading, and a brief time to interact in a "break-out room" small group with a few others around key insights and challenges you received during the large group worship portion.
