


KIDS MINISTRIES LEADERSHIP TEAM (KMLT) MEETING

MUMC Budget Updates

We are very excited to announce that we met our 2019 budget and expenses! Through your Lord's Acre offering, memorials, and other gifts, we were able to pay an additional \$253,000 toward our mortgage principal. Our mortgage balance is now down to \$2,215,732 and we are on a strong pace to pay that off due to your faithfulness and generosity. Thank you!!

We increased our 2020 budget to grow our missions and ministries and to provide for several needed maintenance projects. Here is the breakdown for our 2020 budget of \$2,500,000:

Salaries - \$989,995 Missions - \$315,961 Ministries - \$317,905 Facility Maintenance - \$667,359 Mortgage - \$208,780
