


GUEST PREACHER: REV. DR. CONNIE SHELTON - SUNDAY, JUNE 12

2020/2024 GENERAL CONFERENCE UPDATES



The Judicial Council ruled two weeks that an annual conference of the United Methodist Church cannot leave the denomination as a conference unless the General Conference provides enabling legislation for them to do so. Central Conferences, those outside of the U.S., can leave as an entire conference.

This past week we received news that the Judicial Council ruled that Jurisdictional Conferences may be held. Bishops are elected at the Jurisdictional Conferences and there have been several deaths and retirements of bishops in recent years so there is a significant need for these elections to be made.

We expect the Judicial Council to publish their ruling sometime in mid-summer on whether the delayed General Conference will be a brand new conference or the post-poned 2020 conference. 


SUMMER IN THE PSALMS – TOOLS TO GROW.


On Thursday, June 2, we begin a Bible reading series called "Summer in the Psalms." Each day's readings can be found at www.readpraylovedaily.com (along with supplemental resources not found in the newsletter) or in the newsletter.

We have some resources available in the office to encourage you in your reading and praying of the Psalms: 1) **Praying the Bible** by Donald Whitney (a short book that gives practical instruction on a simple way to let the Bible, esp. the Psalms, be used by the Holy Spirit to guide you into prayer); and, 2) **The Christian Standard Bible Scripture Notebook: Psalms** (a great journaling resource that includes the full text of the Book of Psalms along with journaling space every other page). We can order more if the demand is high.


