MADISON UMC DISAFFILIATION UPDATES

Mississippi Annual Conference disaffiliation vote

The Mississippi Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church will vote on our church’s disaffiliation on Wednesday, June 28.

GMC Church Membership

Hymnals

We are required by our annual conference remove our United Methodist hymnals when we disaffiliate. If you or your family have given a hymnal in honor or in memory of someone, feel free to take that hymnal home with you at an upcoming worship service. We will donate the remaining hymnals to local UMC churches in July.

Stained Glass

We remove Cross & Flame logos from our media and property as part of our disaffiliation agreement. We sent out two panels from a stained-glass window this week to be redesigned to meet that expectation, and it should be back to us very soon.

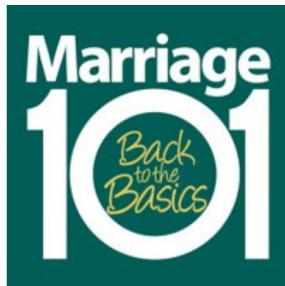
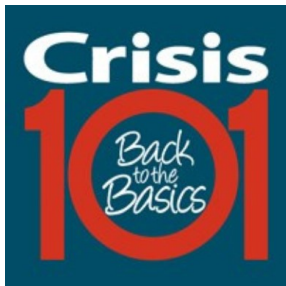

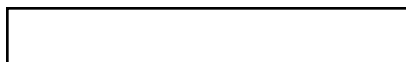
