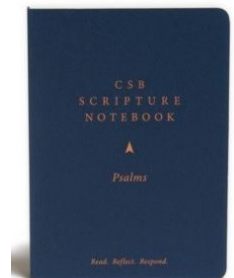
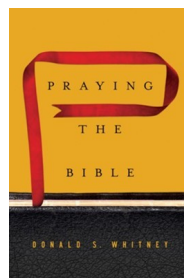

SUMMER IN THE PSALMS – TOOLS TO GROW.

On Thursday, June 2, we begin a Bible reading series called “Summer in the Psalms.” Each day’s readings can be found at www.readpraylovedaily.com (along with supplemental resources not found in the newsletter) or in the newsletter.

We have some resources available in the office to encourage you in your reading and praying of the Psalms: 1) *Praying the Bible* by Donald Whitney (a short book that gives practical instruction on a simple way to let the Bible, esp. the Psalms, be used by the Holy Spirit to guide you into prayer); and, 2) *The Christian Standard Bible Scripture Notebook: Psalms* (a great journaling resource that includes the full text of the Book of Psalms along with journaling space every other page). We can order more if the demand is high.

Either or both books can be purchased online through the QR Code or the link in parentheses (<https://min.link/7TL>). *Praying the Bible* is \$5, and the CSB Psalms Notebook is \$7. You can pick-up copies at the front desk from Jone McCollum.

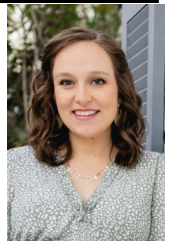
**SUMMER OFFICE HOURS FOR PRESCHOOL
