



I wanted to let you know of a local opportunity to share life and love with others. Please see the write up below from MUMC member, Sarah Largen.



The Connection ministry was started by Chuck and Katie Meador over 17 years ago with a vision to spread the love of Jesus through relationships & friendships. And that is what we strive to be about today. We are a Ridgeland based-youth group with children ages 5-18. We meet the children where they are, creating a safe place for them to just be themselves-some have a home church, most of them do not. Each Wednesday night, we have free time, eat a meal, teach a Bible lesson and discuss the lesson in small groups.

We have an average of 30-40 kids each week. We meet each week on Wednesday nights, volunteers pick up the kids from their neighborhoods starting at 4:45 & we meet from 5-6:30 at Holmes Community College in Ridgeland and on a few Wednesdays, we meet Christ United Methodist Church in Jackson. Over the summer we have special events we do: bowling, baseball game, skating, etc. But we do not meet every Wednesday in the summer.

God has created a wonderful and unique community with this group, many kids attend consistently for years. Our volunteers are from different area churches (First Baptist Madison, Vertical Church, Christ United Methodist, Madison Methodist).
