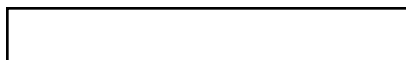

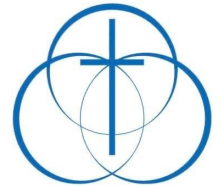

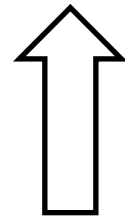

CONFIRMATION

Our Kickoff Event includes: 6th Grade Bible Presentation at both services on **Sunday, September 24** & a dinner/activities for you, your 6th grader, their mentors, & siblings that night **at 6:00 p.m. in the Christian Life Center (CLC)**. A mentor is someone who supports & encourages their Confirmand as they develop/continue a unique relationship with him/her. Being a mentor does not mean that you know all the answers. It does mean that you will share your faith in an authentic way & that you will be a good listener. If you are interested in serving or have questions, please let me know!

3rd, 4th, & 5th grade parents, does your child want to participate in the acolyte ministry at Madison Methodist? We would like to start including the 3rd graders in the acolyte rotation beginning approximately October 2023. Training will be conducted with two children at a time. After we have received the names of the children who wish to participate, a training schedule will be made available for you to choose your training date/time. Children will be mailed a training/information booklet to review prior to their training session.

ALL children have to participate in training before he/she can be placed in the rotation to serve. **At least one parent** will need to attend training with his/her child. This training will help ensure that parents know how to assist their child in getting dressed, how the candle lighters work, & where the supplies are kept.

If your child is not sure he/she wants to acolyte, encourage them to attend training & then make their decision. Let me know if you have questions or need more information.
