SHOWER POWER

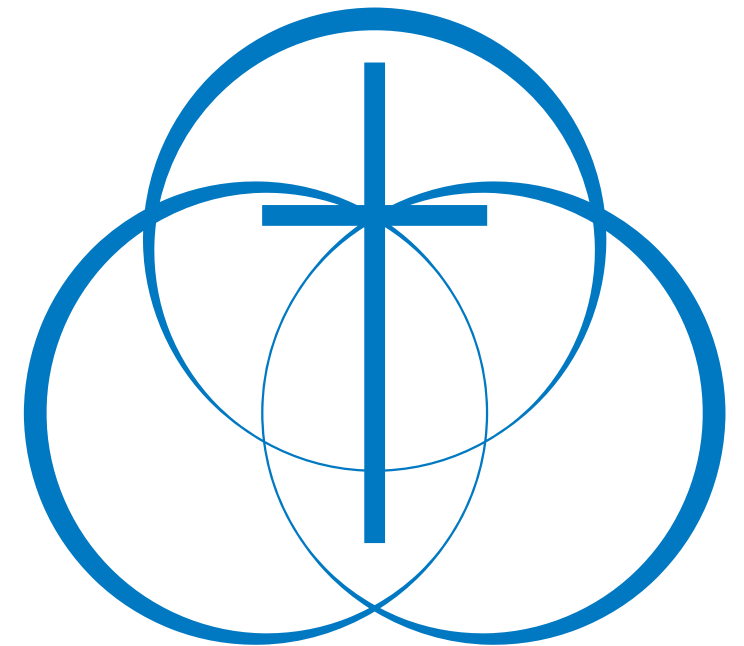
- Thank you for your donations to Shower Power, however, we are still in need of Men’s Boxer Briefs, M-XL.
